





Overview

The De Anza Guided Pathways Villages are designed to provide students with a sense of belonging, connection, and support. This proposal outlines a series of potential, though not all-inclusive, research areas that will be conducted by student interns who work for the De Anza Guided Pathways Villages. The studies will investigate both Village impact and potential areas of growth concerning student support, retention, matriculation, persistence, and degree completion rates, as well as how the Villages support equity, diversity, engagement, and community building.

Potential Research Questions

- O How do, or how might we improve how, the Guided Pathways Villages enhance student support?
- O How do, or how might we improve how, the Guided Pathways Villages contribute to student retention, persistence, and matriculation?
- O How do, or how might we improve how, the Guided Pathways Villages promote equity, inclusion, and diversity to support improved student outcomes?
- O How do, or how might we improve how, the Guided Pathways Villages foster more student engagement in college opportunities?
- O How do, or how might we improve how, the Guided Pathways Villages create a more welcoming and inclusive campus community?

Expected outcomes

The research is expected to produce a number of positive outcomes, including, but not limited to, the following:

- O A better understanding of the impact of the Guided Pathways Villages on student support, retention, persistence, matriculation, equity, engagement, and community building
- O Recommendations for improving the effectiveness of the Guided Pathways Villages
- O A deeper understanding of the historical, social, and cultural significance of community building in education.
- O A collection of research studies and informational posters that describe and explain student research
- A body of research appropriate to sharing in Campus or Community forums
- O A more inclusive and welcoming campus community




